Key Responsibilities and Duties

- To assist in managing the North region's events diary.
- To assist in delivering the annual income budget for the North region, working closely with the existing Community and Regional Fundraiser.
- To follow up and ensure all funds are donated from notified events and recorded correctly on the YAA's database and financial system (CRM).
- To act as an ambassador for the Yorkshire Air Ambulance by undertaking public speaking engagements, attending cheque presentations, and representing the Charity at community events throughout the North region.
- To raise awareness of the Charity in the Region and maximise all income-generating opportunities in the local community, including using social media and other channels.
- To organise and manage the Charity's presence at community events/functions and ensure appropriate fundraiser or volunteer attendance as required. To act as the first point of contact for fundraising events and supporters.
- To recruit, induct and manage the volunteers and ensure they comply with the Charity's policies and procedures.
- To utilize the CRM system to effectively manage our donor base, maximising income.
- Follow the requirements of GDPR, data protection and security.
- To take responsibility for handling cash and dealing directly with the public on behalf of the charity. To comply with the Charity's financial systems and processes and to ensure effective governance.
- A willingness to drive the charity's promotional vehicle. Full training will be provided.
- To be responsible for the region's stock and fundraising resources and notifying when orders need to be placed.
- To plan for and attend regional meetings/planning meetings/volunteer meetings.
- To be responsible for handling cash and dealing directly with the public on behalf of the Charity. To comply with the Charity's financial systems and processes.
- To ensure all systems and processes are followed in accordance with operating procedures.
